The member renewal application period ends January 31, 2018. After that, all applications are considered as new and shall be proposed by the membership chairperson at next board meeting. Membership period is annual - January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2018. No new applications are considered after October 31, 2018.

Board and Member meetings held on the third Thursday of each month at 6:30 pm.

Note: For use of the boat launching facilities, a separate access or annual launching pass application must also be completed.
