Resident members:

- Eligibility requirements - property owners and others who annually reside at least 90 days in the area defined as the junction of Hwy-98 / Hwy-319 on the east and Hwy-98 / Lake Morality Road on the west; north shore of St. George Sound and south property line of St. Joe lands. Capped at 300 resident members.
- Receive a membership card; can attend all LVBC sponsored events; provided one Access Pass. Use of facilities (applicable fees apply). Annual membership fee per applicant /partner is \$15 each.
- Can participate in the governing of the LVBC by serving on the Board of Directors and voting.

Associate members:

- No residency requirements.
- Receives one Access Pass (in lieu of a membership card). Can attend most all LVBC sponsored events; Use of all facilities (applicable fees apply). Annual membership fee per applicant /partner is \$15 each.
- Do not have voting rights and cannot hold a board position but can attend meetings.

Membership period - January 1, 2019 through December 31, 2019. No resident applications are considered after October 31, 2019. Board and Member meetings held on the third Thursday of each month at 6:30 pm.

4th of July	Covered dish/picnic style – burgers and/or hot dogs, drinks, etc. From 12:00 am through 2:00 pm. <i>Volunteers needed - 6 – set-up, serving and clean-up.</i>
Labor Day,	Covered dish/picnic style – burgers and/or hot dogs, drinks, etc. From 12:00 am through 2:00 pm. <i>Volunteers needed - 6 – set-up, serving and clean-up.</i>
Monthly Pancake Breakfast	Full menu served breakfast. Held third Saturday of each month and has several tasks to volunteer for, i.e.: set up; cashier, waitpersons, cooks, dishwasher, assembler, and clean-up. From 9:00 am through 11:00 am. <i>Volunteers needed - 12 – set-up, serving and clean-up.</i>
Christmas Party	Catered Dinner and visit by Santa Claus (Resident Members only). From 5:00 pm through 9:00 pm. <i>Volunteers needed -10 – decorating inside and out, set-up, and clean-up.</i>
Christmas Dinner	Open to all members and public. Covered dishes brought in by attendees, main course (ham and/or turkey) and drinks provided by LVBC. From 1:00 pm through 3:00 pm. <i>Volunteers needed - 6 – set-up, serving and clean-up.</i>
Other volunteer opportunities	Landscaping;/ Yard maintenance; Painting; Carpentry; Pier repair; & Misc. Projects

ACCESS PASS:

This pass identifies that the holder:

- May be on the LVBC property.
- Has use of LVBC facilities (applicable guidelines, application and fees may apply).
- May attend most all events and activities sponsored by LVBC.

Facilities:

- Boat launching ramp – paying a daily launch fee of \$10 or have an Annual Launch Pass.
- Slip - renting overnight (\$10 per night) only if available. Contact Dock Master at 850-528-6766 or by email rampmastermike@gmail.com or to plan ahead - membershiplvbc@gmail.com .
- Daily parking only (no overnight) on LVBC property - access pass must be visible.
- Pavilion and building – upon application and approval of Ways and Means Chairperson prior to use.
- Pier – open access but no boat mooring.
