**The Lanark Village Boat Club (LVBC) has two categories of membership available.

Resident members:

- Eligibility requirements - property owners and others who annually reside at least 90 days in the area defined as the junction of Hwy-98 / Hwy-319 (east) and Hwy-98 / Lake Morality Road (west); north shore of St. George Sound and south property line of St. Joe lands. This membership capped at 300.
- Annual membership fee per applicant /partner is \$15 (each). Issued a **Membership card**; attend all LVBC sponsored events; **issued one Access Pass**; use of facilities (applicable fees may apply).
- Can participate in the governing of the LVBC by serving on the Board of Directors and voting.

Associate members:

- No eligibility requirements.
- Annual membership fee per applicant /partner is \$15 (each). You are **issued one Access Pass**. Can attend most all LVBC sponsored events; and use of facilities (applicable fees apply).
- Can attend meetings but has no voting rights and cannot hold a board position.

*Membership period - January 1, through December 31. No resident applications are considered after October 31st.
Board and Member meetings held on the third Thursday of each month at 6:30 pm.*

4th of July	Covered dish. Burgers, hot dogs, condiments, by LVBC. Members free, non-members - donation. From 12:00 pm through 2:00 pm. <i>Volunteers needed - 6 – set-up, serving and clean-up.</i>
Memorial Day & Labor Day	Covered dish. Burgers, hot dogs, condiments, by LVBC. Members free, non-members - donation. From 12:00 pm through 2:00 pm. <i>Volunteers needed - 6 – set-up, serving and clean-up.</i>

ACCESS PASS or ANNUAL PASS: Must be displayed on the rear-view mirror or dash of the vehicle when on LVBC property. A Pass identifies that you are a member of the LVBC and may:

- *Be on the property and use the pier for viewing, fishing, crabbing, etc. but no vessel mooring.*
- *Apply to use the pavilion and/or building. Application available through the Ways and Means Chairperson.*
- *Launch a boat or kayak – Access Pass pay a per day launch fee of \$10. Annual Launch Pass – unlimited launches.*
- *If available, rent a slip (\$10 per night). Slips are private and only accessible by authorization of the Dockmaster.*

Members may not:

- *Leave vehicles or boat trailers parked overnight without authorization of the Dockmaster.*
- *Fish, swim or throw a castnet from the docks or vessels in the basin.*
- *Allow children under the age of 16 to be on the pier/docks without an adult member present. No swimming off pier.*
- *Leave doggy excrement anywhere on the property (Scoop Their Poop!)*

NOTICE:

- *Member guests or charter clients in single vehicles must pay a \$5 parking fee and park in designated area (follow signage or by direction of Dockmaster (or Rampmaster).*
- *Failure to adhere to these and/or other posted guidelines can result in the loss of access to the LVBC facilities and termination of membership.*
