**The Lanark Village Boat Club (LVBC) has two categories of membership available.  
Check the applicable membership box, complete these two forms and submit with payment.**

**Associate membership:**

- No eligibility requirements. Allows access to property.
- Membership fee per applicant /partner - \$15 (each). Issued one **Access Pass** per each applicant.
- Attend most LVBC sponsored events and use of some amenities
- Can attend meetings but has no voting rights and cannot hold a board position.

**Resident membership:**

- Eligibility requirements - property owners and others who annually reside at least 90 days in the area defined as the junction of Hwy-98 / Hwy-319 (east) and Hwy-98 / Lake Morality Road (west); north shore of St. George Sound and south property line of St. Joe lands. Allows access to property
- Membership fee per applicant /partner - \$15 (each). Issued a **Membership card** and also one **Access Pass** per each applicant; attend all events; and use of all amenities.
- Participate in the governing of the LVBC by serving on the Board of Directors and voting.
- *Resident membership limited to 300 and applications not accepted after October 31<sup>st</sup>.*

*Membership only authorizes your access to LVBC property for period of - January 1<sup>st</sup> - December 31<sup>st</sup>.*

*Other amenities available but require an application along with a separate fee are:*

*Boat and watercraft launching (see page 2). ~ Boat slip and storage rack. ~ Use of building and pavilion.*

*Board and Member meetings held on the third Thursday of each month at 6:30 pm.*

<b>New Year's Day</b>	Covered dish. Burgers, hot dogs, condiments, by LVBC. Members free, non-members - donation. From 11:00 am through 2:00 pm. <i>Volunteers needed - 6 – set-up, serving and clean-up.</i>
<b>Monthly Pancake Breakfast</b>	Served breakfast. Third Saturday of each month, several tasks to volunteer for, i.e.: set-up; cashier, waitpersons, cooks, dishwasher, assembler, and clean-up. From 9:00 am through 11:00 am. <i>Volunteers needed - 12 – set-up, serving and clean-up</i>
<b>Mother's &amp; Father's Day</b>	Celebrated with the closest pancake breakfast. <i>Volunteers needed – 2 more volunteers for decorating</i>
<b>Spring &amp; Fall Bazaar</b>	Arts & Crafts vendors. Spaces rented. Open to the public. From 9:00 am through 2:00 pm. on a Saturday. <i>Volunteers needed - 6 – set-up and clean-up.</i>
<b>Seasonal Barbeque or Fish Fry</b>	Members covered dish. Chicken / fish and condiments by LVBC. Members free, non-members - donation. From 4:00 pm through 6:00 pm. on a Saturday <i>Volunteers needed – 6+ – set-up, serving and clean-up.</i>
<b>4<sup>th</sup> of July &amp; Octoberfest</b>	Members covered dish. Burgers, hot dogs, (or sausages & sauerkraut) and condiments by LVBC. Members free, non-members - donation. From 4:00 pm through 6:00 pm. <i>Volunteers needed – 6+ – set-up, serving and clean-up.</i>
<b>Memorial Day &amp; Labor Day</b>	Covered dish. Burgers, hot dogs, condiments, by LVBC. Members free, non-members - donation. From 12:00 pm through 2:00 pm. on a Monday <i>Volunteers needed - 6 +- set-up, serving and clean-up.</i>
<b>Christmas Party</b>	Catered Dinner ( <i>Resident Members only</i> ). From 5:00 pm through 9:00 pm. On a Saturday <i>Volunteers needed -10 – decorating inside and out, set-up, prep – appetizers / bar and clean-up.</i>

**ACCESS PASS:** *Must be displayed on rear-view mirror or dash of the vehicle when on LVBC property. Allows for:*

- *Using the pier - viewing, fishing, crabbing, etc. (No swimming or vessel mooring allowed at pier.)*
- *Renting the pavilion and/or building –separate Application submitted to the W&M Chairperson.*
- *Per Day - Launching a boat \$10, watercraft \$5; or unlimited launches - \$100 Annual Launch Pass.*
- *Renting Slips / Storage Rack (if available) at \$10 for a 24 hr. period. See Dockmaster or Rampmaster.*
- *Having guests or charter clients – BUT for each single vehicle there is a \$5 per day parking fee (paid at ramp); and must park in designated area (follow signage or by direction of Dockmaster or Rampmaster).*

**NOT ALLOWED ACTIVITIES:**

- *Leaving vehicles or boat trailers parked overnight on property without authorization of the Dockmaster.*
- *Fishing, swimming, or throwing a cast net from the floating docks or vessels in the slips.*
- *Children under 16 yrs. old fishing on pier or jetty without an adult member present.*
- *Leaving doggy excrement anywhere on LVBC property (Scoop Their Poop!).*
- *Disposing of household trash or fish remains in receptacles. Or Dumping fish remains in the basin.*
