## EVENTS;

<b>New Year's Day</b>	Covered dish. Burgers, hot dogs, condiments, by LVBC. Members free, non-members - donation. From 11:00 am through 2:00 pm. <i>Volunteers needed - 6 – set-up, serving and clean-up.</i>
<b>Spring and Fall Bazaar</b>	Arts & Crafts vendors, soups, sandwiches, and dessert items, etc. for sale. Open to the public. From 9:00 am through 2:00 pm. <i>Volunteers needed - 6 – set-up, serving and clean-up.</i>
<b>Mother's and Father's Day</b>	Celebrated with the closest pancake breakfast. <i>Volunteers needed – 2 more volunteers for decorating.</i>
<b>4<sup>th</sup> of July</b>	Covered dish. Burgers, hot dogs, condiments, by LVBC. Members free, non-members - donation. From 12:00 pm through 2:00 pm. <i>Volunteers needed - 6 – set-up, serving and clean-up.</i>
<b>Memorial Day &amp; Labor Day</b>	Covered dish. Burgers, hot dogs, condiments, by LVBC. Members free, non-members - donation. From 12:00 pm through 2:00 pm. <i>Volunteers needed - 6 – set-up, serving and clean-up.</i>
<b>Monthly Pancake Breakfast</b>	Served breakfast. Third Saturday of each month, several tasks to volunteer for, i.e.: set up; cashier, waitpersons, cooks, dishwasher, assembler, and clean-up. From 9:00 am through 11:00 am. <i>Volunteers needed - 12 – set-up, serving and clean-up.</i>
<b>Christmas Party</b>	Catered Dinner (Resident Members only). From 5:00 pm through 9:00 pm. <i>Volunteers needed -10 – decorating inside and out, set-up, and clean-up.</i>
<b>Other volunteer activities</b>	Landscaping;/ Yard maintenance; Painting; Carpentry; Pier repair; misc. projects.

**ACCESS PASS:** must be displayed on the rear-view mirror or dash of the vehicle. See page 2 for guidelines for use of boat launching facilities. The Access Pass holder may:

Be on the LVBC property - daily parking only (no overnight parking).
Launch a boat or kayak – pay a per day launch fee of \$10 or have an Annual Launch Pass.
Rent a slip (\$10 per night if available). Contact Dockmaster by phone or by email
Use pavilion and building - requires an application. Contact Ways and Means Chairperson.
Use the pier for viewing, fishing, crabbing, etc.– but no boat mooring.



# LANARK VILLAGE BOAT CLUB (LVBC) 2020 ANNUAL LAUNCH PASS AND ACCESS PASS GUIDELINES HANDOUT

AVAILABLE ONLY TO RESIDENT OR ASSOCIATE MEMBERS OF THE LVBC

## APPLICATION & GUIDELINES:

- Launch pass period – January 1 – December 31 (no pro-rating of passes).
- **YELLOW Annual Launch Pass** must be visible at all times the vehicle is on Boat Club property -- hang on rear view mirror of launching vehicle.
- A pass is only useable by applicant for launching applicant's boat.
- A pass does not authorize use of the slips.
- If no launch pass is visible, LVBC will consider this as a non-eligible person using the facilities.
- If a parked vehicle with or without a trailer does not have a launch pass (or an access pass) visible, this infraction will be recorded, and repeat infractions could result in loss of use of facilities/privileges.  
*Note: LVBC Dock Master (or assigned Ramp Master/agent) oversees launching activities.*

## GENERAL FACILITIES USAGE:

1. Maximum length of any boat launched is 26 feet.
2. No gas or oil is to be deposited in the boat basin or on LVBC property.
3. Comply with "NO WAKE" zone – *a wake is generating white water (breaking wave) behind boat.*
4. Launching Pass allows for launching of non-powered watercraft in designated area next to pier.
5. Parking:
  - Designated parking available on LVBC property - area south and west of ramp, east of the Lanark Mart or at the LVBC building area. Must adhere to all parking signs or posted notices.
  - Overnight parking (vehicles and/or trailers) is not allowed without prior LVBC authorization.
  - Member guests/clients in separate vehicles pay a \$5 parking fee. Launch pass holder responsible for this.
  - **Charter Captains are responsible for ensuring client has paid vehicle parking fee (\$5 per vehicle).**

**Infractions:** Notification (a ticket) of an infraction will be placed under the windshield wiper of launching vehicle and recorded in the LVBC data base. Repeat infractions (2 or more) of rules or posted notices can result in cancellation of a launching pass (written notification). Grievances may be presented at any board meeting.

**Liability disclaimer:** Neither the LVBC nor its agents, officers, and directors shall be liable for damages for injury to person or damages to or loss of property where ever located from any cause, or for damage claimed for removal of a boat, goods or effects as herein provided for eviction, actual or constructive. This statement includes particularly, but not exclusively, all claims arising for fire, theft, rain damage, unlocked boats, storm, power outage, improper electrical hook-up and vandalism. If insurance coverage is desired to protect the boat, goods, or other effects during the terms of this agreement from all loss of damage, owner shall independently purchase such insurance. The members, its agents, servants, or guests, or any person using the LVBC facilities shall hold the LVBC harmless from any claims, expenses, loss or liabilities arising out of any occurrences as a result for the use of the boat basin, ramp and parking area.
